## 6: Scholarship Details

1. A Scholarship is provided every 2 years for an inspiring, committed, aspiring and passionate newly graduated Tasmanian chef whose beliefs align with the Slow Food ethos.
2. The scholarship winner must go to Italy in time to participate in the September 2016 SF's Terra Madre/Salone del Gusto. SFH in conjunction with SFI and the successful candidate will develop a timeline for learning, experiencing, mentoring and studying Italian food, its culture, chefs from the SF Chef Alliance and artisan producers. The winner must be free of all Australian job commitments whilst on the Scholarship
3. After short-listing the candidates, the short listed candidates will be informed and requested to
  - a. Develop a 4 course Autumnal menu for 4 people – costed at \$45 per person ( food only) with suggestions for matching wines
  - b. Be prepared to create the entrée course of the Autumnal Menu (salad) for 4 people at a cost of \$9.50 pp. Cost of entrée course to be funded by applicant. Tasters will be the selection panel
  - c. Participate in a face to face interview conducted by the selection panel - SFH chair and 3 Industry/ SFH /TasTAFE representatives. This selection will be approved by the SFH committee
4. After the successful candidate is announced and the signing of the Scholarship agreement and travel arrangements are formalized, SFH will arrange a financial package to cover return airfares from Tasmania to Italy and an expenses allowance to the value of \$AU6000.00
5. The successful candidate will take out comprehensive travel insurance for the period of the scholarship
